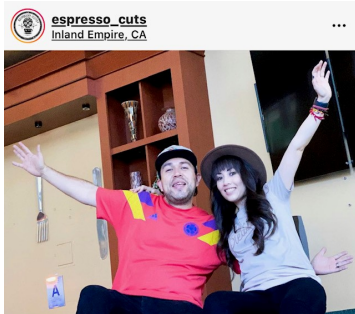
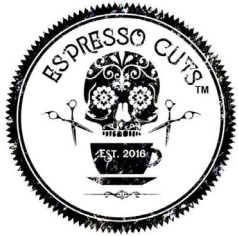


City of Ontario Updates DOIA Board Meeting October 28, 2021

New Projects:

The Vault

A Disposition and Development Agreement (DDA) was approved on September 21st by the City Council for 125 W Emporia Street. The infill, mixed-use project will transform a surface parking lot into a 39,000 sf building with retail/restaurant pads, storage space for exotic and recreational vehicles, and future office space.

C-Block

400+ space parking garage will be complete in Spring 2022. Ultimately, mixed-use project will include 150 units and 6,000 sf of retail space.

A-Block

Working towards Development Agreement (Early 2022). Mixed-use project with 250 units, 2 restaurants, distillery and new public plaza.
